Bill C-51: Greenpeace to appear before Standing Committee on Public Safety and National Security

10 March 2015 (Ottawa) – Greenpeace Canada has been invited to appear before the Standing Committee on Bill C-51. Greenpeace welcomes the opportunity to stand behind the work of 100 legal scholars who describe this bill as ‘dangerous legislation’ and ask that it be wiped out or at least thoroughly amended.
