Edmontonians to pack council chambers to show support for Energy Transition Strategy

April 28, 2015 (Edmonton) – Tomorrow morning, Edmonton City Council will debate whether to move forward on a plan to help transition the city to a low-carbon economy by 2050. The Energy Transition Strategy has been under development for years. Mayor Iveson made it a focal point on his State of the City address on Monday, but it has come under fire from a few councilors.

Yesterday, over 40 businesses and associations sent a letter to the City Council supporting the plan and tomorrow over 50 local community members are expected to attend the meeting to show council the community's support for the plan.
