One last debate in Montreal before elections day

13 October 2015 (Montreal) – The candidates in the federal election for the district of [LaSalle-Émard-Verdun](#), in the southwest of Montreal, will participate tonight in what will probably be the very last public debate before the vote on 19 October.

This event, jointly organized by the [Comité d'action des citoyennes et citoyens de Verdun \(CACV\)](#) and Greenpeace Canada, will be led by an independent moderator and will include the topics of economy, the fight against poverty, access to housing, the environment as well as the solutions to these issues.
