## **Solar and Bike Powered Outdoor Movie Coming to Alberta Legislature**

**Edmonton** – On Tuesday, August 23<sup>rd</sup> using just the power of the sun and bicycles Greenpeace is bringing an outdoor screening of the childhood classic *FernGully* to the Alberta legislature. The family friendly event is designed to help showcase the power of renewables and push the government to prioritize community and First Nation ownership in Alberta’s energy transition.
