Canada is at it again! Not only is the Canadian government allowing hundreds of thousands of baby seals to be killed this year, it is actively promoting this massive hunt.

Thanks to past efforts of Greenpeace and other groups, seal populations have finally begun to recover. But threats like global warming and overfishing leave the fate of the seals in a precarious state.

Polar ecosystems are among the first places to suffer impacts of global warming, and populations of seals, polar bears and other wildlife have already been affected. Harp seal populations rely on sea ice for breeding, resting and nursing. As global warming melts more and more of the ice, seals have less and less room to survive.
