supported by a fellowship from the Resource  
Science Centre under Dr. C.S. Halling and  
by a Canada Council Grant.

I have been active in environmental  
matters in the case of the Utah mine on  
Rupert Inlet. I represented the Pacific  
Salmon Society at the Pollution Control Board  
hearings in Port Hardy, on Dec 2/70 and ex-  
pressed my views on the matter in news-  
papers, radio and television.

I am completely familiar with large  
fishing boats as I grew up on the West  
Coast of Vancouver Island and have often  
been out to sea fishing. I am able to  
operate much of the equipment on board  
and would be capable of operating the  
entire boat if the situation arose.
