Changemaker Space Community Manager

Background

Greenpeace Africa is a growing movement of people acting in response to the climate crisis. Our campaigns use peaceful, creative confrontation to expose environmental injustices in Africa and develop solutions for a green and peaceful future.

In attempts to support growing global youth movements for climate justice, Greenpeace has collaborated with Fryshuset to establish 6 Changemaker Spaces in and across Africa and Europe. Changemaker Spaces will be physical spaces to help youths interact with each other to ignite and accelerate actions on the climate crisis at home and globally.

Overview of purpose of the role:

The Changemaker Space Community Manager is responsible for delivery of the project in Nairobi, Kenya and task-gives a freelance or some shorter term part-time position (max 15 hours/week over the project period to assist with day to day running of the space). They are responsible for establishing and managing the Changemaker space in Nairobi in collaboration with relevant stakeholders and will create necessary environments and support for young people in conducting advocacy work.

KEY ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Coordinating projects for young activists and climate-engaged youths

- (In the first year of assignment), Identify and establish a physical location of the Changemaker space within the vicinity of Nairobi
- Operationalise the physical location with necessary equipments and create conducive and inspiring environments for young people
- Outreach to individuals, groups and organisations that are engaged in climate activism
- Coordinate exchanges and collaboration with peers for Changemaker spaces in other locations
- Support young people in developing advocacy and campaigning activities

Facilitation of workshops and content creation

- Design, organise, and facilitate workshops offline and online that suit the needs of youths
- Create digital contents in line with Changemaker teams while ensuring that it is locally contextualised
- Create locally relevant content and materials as required

Monitoring and evaluation of the maker spaces impact

- Generate information and statistics on activities and initiatives for Monthly/quarterly/ annual reporting
- Coordinate with the Changemaker space global team to share learnings
- Develop data tracking tools
- Draft progress reports on the space

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS, SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE

- Bachelor's Degree, preferably in Project Management or related field
- 3 or more years' experience in project management and/or coordination
- 3 or more years' experience in movement work or community organising
- Experience in training, coaching, mentoring young people.
