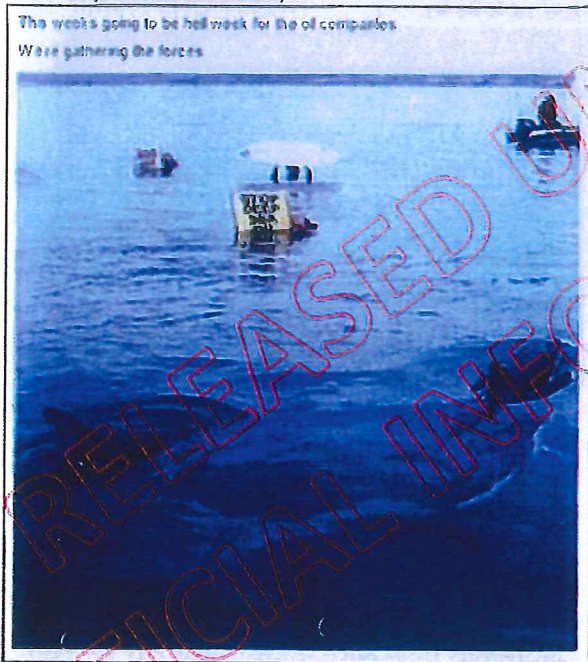

- The Facebook event page currently indicates 224 people attending with a further 534 interested however this is a notoriously unreliable indicator of true numbers which are expected to be considerably higher.
- Unite Union are now promoting the event to their supporters
- A number of buses are organised to bring protesters to New Plymouth (from Auckland, Hamilton & Wellington)
- There is private transport / car-sharing being arranged from most towns around the North Island and from Nelson, Christchurch, Kaikoura & Dunedin in the South.
- Owae marae is the main accommodation centre for protesters from outside the region though many are also taking up offers of boarding with local activists/supporters.

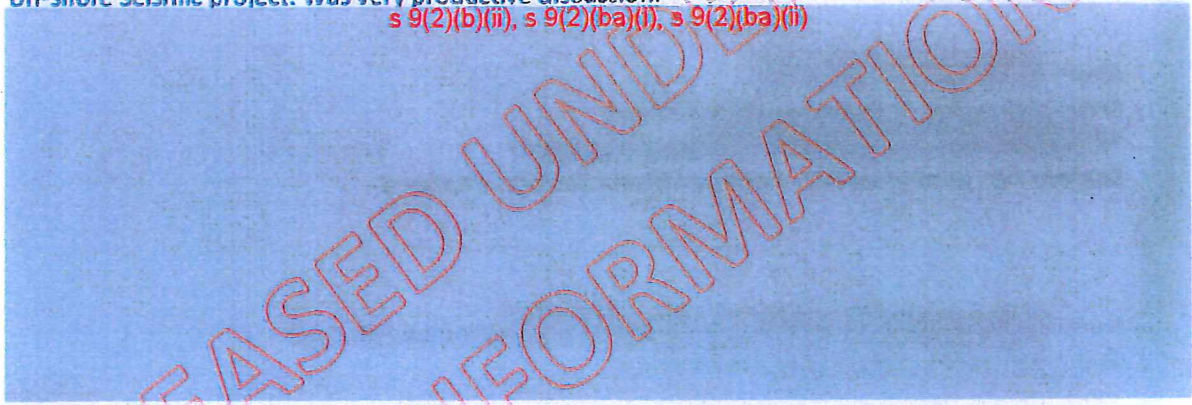

Protesters surrounded an Australian company's gold exploration drilling site in Northland, New Zealand. About 200 people knocked down the barriers and went onto Evolution Mining's drilling site on the slopes of Puhipuhi mountain north of Whangarei on Sunday.

"Evolution Mining has been telling their Australian investors they have the support of the local hapu and community. But look at this crowd from the whole of the region - it sets that record straight," says MineWatch Northland spokesman Tim Howard.

"Evolution Mining has no social licence to be here. They are not wanted here in any shape or form."

Marchers raised the Ngati Hau, United Tribes and Maori flags on drilling equipment, along with banners and placards.

Environmental campaigner Hori Chapman said mining was the opposite of what was needed for a prosperity in the region.

"Our focus is on healing the land, not poisoning it and our waterways with toxic mining waste. Heal the land and we'll heal the people."

There was also a protest at the drilling site in June.

Evolution acquired the Puhipuhi exploration permit in June 2015.

The company is in the early stages of an exploration program to find out whether there are gold and silver deposits at Puhipuhi that can be mined by underground methods.

"We are committed to engaging with tangata whenua, the community and key stakeholders throughout all stages of the exploration process," the company says on its website.

The company says it's uncertain if any deposits exist and establishing a mine at Puhipuhi is years away and may not occur at all.

Coromandel conservation group Protect Karangahake has staged another protest at Newcrest Mining Ltd's gold exploration drilling rig on the side of Mt Karangahake, temporarily shutting down the drill.

The group arrived at around 11am, crossing the marked worksite boundary. Newcrest says the drill rig was immediately shut down for the safety of the drilling team and the protesters.

Police were called and issued five of the protesters with trespass notices. The group left the site about two hours after arriving, at which time drilling started up again.

Protect Karangahake chairman Duncan Shearer says the group wants to protect the mountain from mining "however necessary".

"Karangahake is a precious ecological corridor and a visitor hotspot. Each year locals and tens of thousands of visitors come here to enjoy the regenerating native flora and fauna, and we think that is worth protecting."

Mr Shearer says the "growing tourism industry" would sustain the local community and economy far better than mining.

"We realised that letting them sample is the start of a slippery slope, potentially leading to full-scale mining and all the contamination and degradation that comes with it," he says.

A Newcrest spokesperson says district permits and landowner permission is sought before any work commences.

"Environmental management plans are developed to identify and outline controls to prevent potential environmental impacts during the establishment of the drill site and during drilling activity.

"All drill sites will be fully rehabilitated once drilling has been completed."

Last Tuesday, the same group protested outside the site and delivered a letter to the mining company, which is based in Australia.

Newcrest is one of the world's largest gold mining companies, with mines in Australia, Papua New Guinea, Indonesia and West Africa.

The current drill site is on two exploration areas -- Waitekauri and Owharoa -- under current permits issued by the New Zealand Government.

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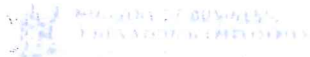

Te Reinga Basin Anti Deep Sea Oil Drilling Hikoi from Cape Te Reinga to Waitangi

A hikoi calling for national support to protect the 4th largest Marine area in the world will leave Cape Te Reinga on the 1st of February and travel to Waitangi and arrive before the 6th of February to protest against deep sea oil drilling in Te Reinga Basin. A foreign Oil Drilling vessel owned by Statoil will arrive from Norway to drill into the Te Reinga Basin seabed at depths over more than 2000 metres looking for oil.

Despite unanimous resolutions at numerous hui by many hapu and iwi all around Tai Tokerau to fully oppose all deep sea oil exploration have been conducted last year, but has fallen on deaf government ears.

In April, 2004 over 40,000 Māori and supporters marched to Wellington in the Takutaimoana Hikoi led by Hone Harawira to oppose the infamous Foreshore and Seabed legislation. The Bill was a New Zealand government knee-jerk reaction to a court order that recognised Māori rights to the foreshore and seabed. Māori suspected that the government was planning to allow foreign investment into the seabed to explore for minerals and oil.
