



How to leave a gift in your Will to Greenpeace Aotearoa

Sample wording to leave a gift to Greenpeace:

To leave a gift to Greenpeace in your Will, it is important to use our full legal name: Greenpeace Aotearoa Incorporated

"I give to Greenpeace Aotearoa Incorporated.....% of my estate OR the rest and residue of my estate OR the sum of \$..... (fixed amount) for its general purposes free of probate and estate duties payable upon or in consequence of my death. I declare that the receipt of its Executive Director, Treasurer or other authorised officer shall be sufficient discharge to my executors."

To ensure your wishes are met, it is important that you speak to a legal advisor
