Dan Hindsgaul, Board Chair (2016-2028)

Dan Hindsgaul was elected as a member of the Greenpeace Nordic Board of Directors in 2016. Dan is an experienced international campaigner and communicator in the fields of human rights, democratization, environmental protection and WMD disarmament. In 2022, Dan was elected as the Board Chair for Greenpeace Nordic. He currently works as the Head of Policy at Save the Children Denmark. Dan lives in Denmark.



Per Rosander, Board member (2019-2028)

As a trained chemist, Per has devoted most of his professional life to reducing the burden of toxic chemicals to health and environment. He headed the Toxic Campaign for Greenpeace Sweden from 1988 through 1995. In 2003 Per started the International Chemical Secretariat (ChemSec), an NGO acting to promote stronger chemical legislation in particular on EU and global level, and was the ED of the organisation for a number of years. Per is currently an environmental strategist at Region Västra Götaland in Western Sweden, where he works on issues such as green procurement and waste reduction. Per lives in Sweden.



Carl-Henrik Monrad-Aas, Board member (2022-2028)

Carl-Henrik Monrad-Aas was elected to the Greenpeace Nordic Board in 2022 and is the trustee of Greenpeace Nordic since December 2025. From 1997 to 2022, Carl-Henrik served as a voting member of Greenpeace Nordic. Carl-Henrik was involved in establishing the first Greenpeace Sweden office in 1983 and later held different positions in the organization, including Press Officer, Fundraising Officer, Actions Coordinator and Campaigner. Carl-Henrik is a trained copywriter and communications specialist. His last position before retiring in May 2026, was as a strategist at The Bond Communication Agency in Gothenburg, Sweden, where his work included advising companies and organisations on brand strategy, corporate communications and advertising. Carl-Henrik lives in Sweden.

**Sandra Butoyi, Board member (2024-2027)**

Sandra Butoyi was elected as a member of the Greenpeace Nordic Board in May 2024. Sandra is an environmental and political campaigner who has experience from NGOs such as Natur og Ungdom, Operasjon Dagsverk, and the Norwegian Civil Service Union (NTL). She was a central board member of Natur og Ungdom from 2020-2021, working on communication in their climate lawsuit with Greenpeace, and in their green transition group. From June 2021 to July 2023, Sandra was the CEO of Natur og Ungdom, overseeing the organisation's finances and leading organisational development processes. She is currently completing a Bachelors in Public Administration and Management at the University of Oslo, and working as an Organisational Consultant at Naturvernforbundet. Sandra lives in Norway.

**Jussi Nuortimo, Board member (2024-2027)**

He currently works as the Head of Dialogue (Product and Data) at iloom, a start up who develops an AI natural language process platform for top Finnish multinational companies. Previously, Jussi was a member on the Board of the University of Helsinki (2014-2018), and is the current vice chair of the Social Science Professionals (YKA) trade union. Jussi lives in Finland.

**Charlotte Baumann, board member (2025-2028)**

Charlotte Baumann was elected as a member of the Greenpeace Nordic Board of Directors in 2025.
