

INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges that:

GENERAL ALLEGATIONS

At all times material to this Indictment:

- 1. GREENPEACE, INC. was incorporated under the laws of California and was doing business under the name GREENPEACE USA.
 - 2. SCOTT ANDERSON was employed by GREENPEACE, INC. as a "climber."
 - 3. HILLARY HOSTA was employed by GREENPEACE, INC. as a "climber."
- 4. The "M/V APL Jade" was a vessel owned and operated by APL Limited for the purpose of transporting cargo by sea.

COUNT 1

From a date unknown to the Grand Jury, but at least as early as on or about April 6, 2002, and continuing through on or about April 12, 2002, in Miami-Dade County, in the Southern District of Florida, and elsewhere, the defendant,

GREENPEACE, INC., d/b/a "Greenpeace USA."

did knowingly and willfully combine, conspire, confederate, and agree with SCOTT ANDERSON, MARK DOMBOWSKY, HILLARY HOSTA, JEREMY PASTER, SCOTT PAUL, PELLE PETTERSON, and others known and unknown to the Grand Jury, without being in the United States service and without being duly authorized by law for the purpose, to go on board a vessel, namely, the "M/V APL Jade," which was about to arrive at the place of her destination, namely, the Port of Miami, before her actual arrival, and before she had been completely moored; in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2279.

Purpose and Object of the Conspiracy

It was a purpose and object of the conspiracy to place individual members, employees, and agents of the defendant on board the cargo vessel "M/V APL Jade," without the cargo vessel's permission and without other lawful authority.

Manner and Means

The manner and means by which the defendant and other participants sought to accomplish the purpose and object of the conspiracy included the following:

- It was part of the conspiracy that the defendant hired the individual co-conspirators as "climbers," whose job was to go on board the "M/V APL Jade."
- 2. It was further a part of the conspiracy that the defendant selected the "M/V APL lade" as the target of the conspiracy based upon the defendant's erroneous belief that the "M/V APL lade" carried a shipment of Brazilian mahogany lumber.
- 3. It was further a part of the conspiracy that the defendant caused the individual coconspirators and small boats registered to the defendant to be transported to Miami
 Beach, Florida, in preparation for the boarding of the "MV APL Jade."

Overt Acts

In furtherance of this conspiracy and to effect the object thereof, there was committed by at least one of the co-conspirators herein, at least one of the following overt acts, among others, in the Southern District of Florida:

- 1. On or about April 12, 2002, SCOTT ANDERSON, HILLARY HOSTA, JEREMY PASTER, PELLE PETTERSSON, and other persons known to the Grand Jury were on board 2 vessel bearing registration number MD1485BN, which was registered to GREENPEACE, INC.
- 2. On or about April 12, 2002, PELLE PETTERSSON operated a vessel bearing registration number MD1485BN, which was registered to GREENPEACE, INC.
- 3. On or about April 12, 2002, MARK DOMBOWSKY and other persons known to the Grand Jury were on board a vessel bearing registration number MD0467BG, which was registered to GREENPEACE, INC.
- 4. On or about April 12, 2002, MARK DOMBOWSKY operated a vessel bearing registration number MD0467BG, which was registered to GREENPEACE, INC.
- 5. On or about April 12, 2002, JEREMY PASTER chartered a vessel bearing registration number FL3476LD, using American Express credit card number 3783 062275 01008, at Club Nautico, 300 Alton Road, Suite 112, Miami Beach, Florida.
- 6. On or about April 12, 2002, SCOTT PAUL and other persons known to the Grand
 Jury were on board a vessel bearing registration number FL3476LD.
- 7. On or about April 12, 2002, SCOTT ANDERSON and HILLARY HOSTA boarded the "M/V APL Jade" as it approached the Port of Miami, Florida, on an international voyage.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 371.
